

لائحة قواعد وأنظمة الإمتحانات النهائية

- يجب إبراز البطاقة الأكاديمية (ID) ووضعها على المنضده أثناء الإمتحان.
- لايسمح للطالبة الخروج من القاعة في أي حال من الأحوال خلال 30 دقيقة الأولى من وقت بدأ الإمتحان.
- لايسمح للطالبة الإحتفاظ ب أو استعمال أي من هذه الأجهزه: الهاتف النقال،
 الأجهزه الذكية والرقمية بجميع أنواعها، الآلات الحاسبة الغير مسموح بها.
- يجب إغلاق الهاتف النقال ووضعه في المكان المناسب حسب تعليمات المراقب ويمنع منعاً باتاً استخدامه في أي حال من الأحوال.
- على الطالبة الجلوس في القاعة حسب قائمة الأسماء ويمنع تغييرها منعاً باتاً.
- يمنع التحدث، الإلتفاف، إزعاج الآخرين ، استعارة أي غرض أو محاولة الغش منعاً باتاً، علماً بأنه سيتم اتخاذ اللازم من قبل اللجنة التاديبية.



- Students must have a valid RUW student ID card to enter the exam hall. Forgetfulness is not an acceptable excuse.
- Once students have presented themselves for an examination, they must write that exam and submit all written work sheets and question papers to the invigilator before leaving.
- Students are not permitted to enter the exam hall if they arrive more than 30 minutes after the advertised time.
- Students are not permitted to leave the exam hall until 30 minutes have elapsed from the start of exam time.



- Students are not permitted to have in their possession any unauthorised items such as cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, PDAs and other web-access de-vices during an examination (excluding approved calculators).
- Answering mobile phones or sending and receiving text messages is considered as cheating during an examination.
- All students are responsible for making themselves aware of the University examination regulations and the Student Code of Conduct and disciplinary procedures. These are available on the RUW website and in the Student Handbook.
- It is the responsibility of the students to check the date, time and venue of the examinations by checking examination schedules posted on the Registrar's notice board and on the RUW website.



- Unauthorised communication between students during an examination either through speech, in-writing, electronic means such as text messaging or BBM or any other form of transmission is not permitted and shall be considered as violation of examination hall rules.
- Cheating in examination includes but is not confined to copying from another's paper, giving or receiving unauthorised assistance, obtaining unauthorised advance knowledge of questions on an examination, and using mechanical or making devices or procedures to achieve false scores on machine graded examinations.



- Students are reminded that cheating in any examination is considered a serious offence which could lead to expulsion from the University.
- The invigilator is authorised to verbally warn/move/or confiscate students answer sheet if cheating occurs.
- Students who may require special assistance for examinations should consult with the Dean of Faculty. The Dean of Faculty will notify the Registrar.
- Students are cautioned not to make travel arrangements to leave Bahrain prior to the end of any scheduled examination period
