Our main focus is on academic excellence and personal development. RUW's Initial degree programmes were designed in collaboration with two reputed universities, McGill University in Canada and Middlesex University in the United Kingdom.

RUW History:

The first meeting of the Educational Projects Company (EPC) to establish the Royal University for Women (RUW) Founding Committee took place in February 2002. According to letter No. 19/ 1/ issued by the Royal Court dated on 09 July 2002, and Ministerial Order No. 1462002/, dated 16 July 2002 issued by the Ministry of Education; a special university for women was licensed for operation. In letter No. 3042002/ dated 02 November 2002 issued by the Ministry of Education, the name 'Royal University for Women' was confirmed. RUW opened enrolment in a temporary venue in October 2005. In August 2006, the RUW permanent campus in Riffa was opened.

RUW Campus:

RUW offers its students the opportunity to acquire internationally recognised credentials as well as to enable its students to develop the personal skills and confidence necessary to excel in every area of their personal and professional life. Located in the Kingdom of Bahrain RUW's extensive campus facilities offer an environment where the best of Western and Middle Eastern values are reflected. RUW's custom-built campus houses studios, lecture halls and information technology labs, to optimise the learning experience. In addition to its educational facilities, the Student Centre facility includes a variety of dining options as well as a 'Mini Market'. Student Council offices as well as the Clinic are located in the Student Centre. The dedicated Sports Centre includes a swimming pool, fully equipped Gym as well as saunas and shower facilities.

(formally College of Business and Financial Sciences)

The primary objective of business studies is to prepare students for professional and managerial careers in organisations that includes developing a capacity for critical thinking and problem solving. Moreover, students learn to integrate knowledge across different disciplines, and contemporary theory in approaching practical business problems. Students are expected to develop self-management skills, to work successfully in teams, and to grow their leadership skills.

College of Business and Law (CBL) at RUW prepares the students with business fundamentals that allow them to turn their passions into successful careers. The BA in Business provides a well-rounded professional education that consists of university general requirement courses, liberal arts required courses, a business core, and a year of courses emphasizing the student's major. CBL in the Business Department offers Four Degree Programmes, Human Resources, Business in Banking & Finance, Business in Marketing and International Business.



COLLEGE OF BUSINESS AND LAW PROFILE

(formally College of Law)

The College of Business and Law (CBL) plays an integral role in the achievement of RUW's main mission of excellence, providing scientific knowledge and offering a teaching methodology that brings harmony between Middle Eastern legal traditions and the main international legal trends.

Our law programme provides teaching that is globally oriented, addresses the needs of the market, and leads to local regional and international careers. The law programme is the only programme in the Kingdom which is bilingual with content being delivered 60% in English and 40% in Arabic.

Law studies open many paths for the students: their studies can take them to domestic law-related professions such as lawyer, judge's public Notaries, legal consultants, or employees in the public administration. The international field is also an option to choose to become diplomats, international lawyers, or judges, or to work in international organisations.

CBL Bachelor of Law enhances the intellectual capacity of the students by encouraging critical thinking through a teaching methodology based on research and practical exercises, in order to better understand how to relate the legal theories to the practice. The programme involves its students in the numerous academic activities, seminars, and conferences that are held locally or at Partner institutions abroad.

Extra-curricular activities, such as the law clinic takes place in cooperation with practicing lawyers from the most prestigious law firms in Bahrain, help the students to develop a practical approach to problemsolving in legal cases.

As part of the learning process, CBL encourages students' participation in the development of community life as part of their personal development, based on the values of academic excellence and positive cooperation with local and international partners. Internships are, hence, an essential part of the curriculum in order to allow students to develop employability and advocacy skills. This also happens through the participation in international Legal competitions such as Willem C. Vis International Moot Court Competition in Commercial Arbitration held every year in Vienna among more than 300 university teams worldwide.

Our curriculum is in tune with those of leading Law faculties in the world and is designed to connect the local with the global outlooks, constantly promoting and pursuing cooperation, and exchanges of expertise with leading universities in order to ensure that international standards are met. Over the last few years, qualified academics from the University of Cambridge contributed to the verification of the programme and to its improvement.

Our programme is delivered by highly qualified professors from different countries and different legal backgrounds. They bring their diversified expertise to prepare our students for the modern legal world through regular participation in international seminars, scholarly research, and publication, and by keeping our students informed of the latest advances in the legal field. The CBL, Law team is committed to the success of Law students in order for them to become real leaders in their community and participate in the overall development of their country.

Recently, our Law students took part in the fourth edition of the SCCA Arabic Moot in Commercial Arbitration, where students from Law and Sharia colleges from around the world (110 Teams; 20 Jurisdictions) come together to compete in hypothetical arbitration cases, that simulate real-world international commercial arbitration cases.

The team took a turn playing the roles of both the Claimant and the Respondent by submitting written briefs and presenting oral arguments in a hypothetical arbitration case before top international arbitrators. The team was awarded 2nd runner up and won an honourable mention for our Memorandum for Claimant (4th Place). Moreover, one of our oralists was honoured for her individual advocacy skills.

Our college's strong public and private sector linkages ensure rich learning experiences and provide further opportunities for experiential learning. CBL has Memoranda of Understanding with banks, companies, ministries, NGO's and international organisations of eminence that will help students find a quality internship opportunities and provide them with real-life experience on the job. Collaborating closely with other higher education institutions in the world. Among our partners, we count West Virginia University, Pittsburgh University, both in USA, Bangor University, UK, and La Rochelle Business School, France. CBL offers study abroad opportunities as well as international education trips that will expose our students to amazing international experiences and support their learning in a truly global context.

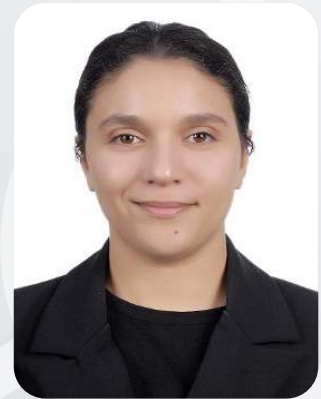

CENTRE FOR GENERAL STUDIES – PROFILE

The Centre for General Studies (CGS) offers both English for Academic Success (EAS) programme and Liberal Arts Requirement (LAR) courses. The CGS is expanding its function by offering Professional Certificates and Soft Skills Programmes through our unique partnership with Pearson Education.

English for Academic Success (EAS) Programme

The English for Academic Success (EAS) Programme is a preparatory one-year programme, which is assured by Pearson, UK and systematically develops the skills, knowledge and attitudes necessary for academic and personal success in subsequent undergraduate degree programmes at the University. EAS courses are designed to enhance the language proficiency of students who do not meet the minimum linguistic proficiency level required to pursue their academic studies. The communicative pedagogical approach is used to develop the student language related skills, abilities and attributes. The EAS programme optimizes the students' learning experience by utilizing authentic appealing materials that caters to individuality and assures the students motivation, engagement, and autonomy. Students are equipped to be confident collaborative independent life-long learners. They are also prepared to be global citizens by celebrating other cultures and having the essence of acceptance and appreciation.

Liberal Arts Requirement (LAR) Courses

Liberal Arts Requirement (LAR) Courses are elective courses offered to all RUW students as part of their university studies. LAR courses do not emphasise any specific specialization but develop the students' rational thought and intellectual capacities in general. Such courses pertain to general knowledge and life skills. The LAR courses at RUW are categorized into two groups: knowledge-based courses and skills-based courses. They generally aim at imparting knowledge and developing student's critical thinking and intellectual capabilities. Whether the courses are based on foreign languages, humanities, history, social sciences, natural sciences, arts, literature or philosophy, students acquire skills that are invaluable to their educational experience. Through lectures, class discussions and blended learning approaches, students enhance their ability to explain ideas, apply theories, solve hypothetical queries and demonstrate conceptual understanding.
